

# QR Code Generator

## What are they?

A QR Code is a shortcut to a website, or other resource like contact information.

## How do you read them?

You need a barcode scanner or QR Code reader for a smart device like your smart phone or tablet. These apps are free! There are apps that charge a fee but the free ones were just as well.

Android users – check out QR Droid

Apple users – check out QR Reader for iPhone

## Why would you use one?

- Create a QR Code for your School Center page and put it on your syllabus.
- Create QR Codes for each of the websites you want students to use for a research project.
- Create a QR Code for your contact information to give to parents at Parent Teacher Conferences.
- Create QR Codes for your team to link to the team's website for practice/game information.

## How do you make them?

Search for QR Code Generators or go to **goqr.me**





Example – This “qrcode” became “CLHS Media”
