StandardsInsightMN™ allows users to filter the standards by keyword, by grade level, by strand, by College and Career Readiness (CCR) anchor standards for English Language Arts, and/or by domain or conceptual category for Mathematics. Filtering allows teacher teams to look at vertical connections among strands of standards, search for specific content relevant to their alignment work, and conduct deep study of the standards. The system provides open, customizable architecture for local curriculum work.

The online system provides a robust database, with five fields of unpacked content that identify:

- Evidence of student attainment
- Key vocabulary for teachers
- Knowledge expected to accomplish the standard
- Skills needed to meet the standard
- Understandings required to achieve the standard

An additional six custom fields support teacher collaboration to meet specific needs in aligning core initiatives (e.g., literacy plans, differentiating instruction, assessment design, professional learning communities, learning targets, interventions, etc.).

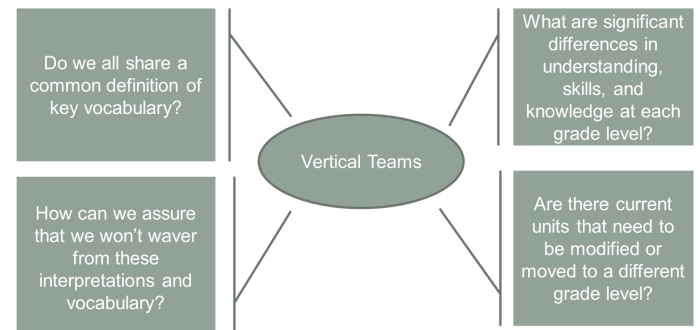
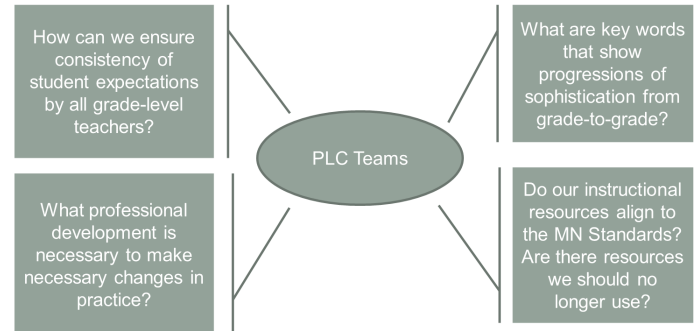
