

Web 2.0 Code of Ethics for Elementary Students

Web 2.0 tools are tools we use to communicate with other people on the Internet. Some examples include Google Apps, MOODLE, blogs, wikis, and Voicethread.

In order to use these tools safely and responsibly, I promise to do the following things whenever I am using these tools:

1. I will be careful to keep my personal information private. I will not share any information about myself that can be used to locate me or contact me. These include pictures of myself, my last name, passwords, email address, home address, phone numbers, school name, etc...
2. I will be careful to keep my password private, even from my friends. I understand that I should never login as someone other than myself.
3. I will treat everyone online respectfully. I will not make fun or threaten anyone online.
4. I will not share anything online that is not my own creation. I understand that pictures, videos, music, and text made by other people is their property and I must get permission before using their things.
5. I will not download or install any software, or purposely click on links that are not appropriate for school.
6. I will try at all times to check that the information I share online is accurate. I will share where I find the information and report any information that is inaccurate to your teacher.
7. I will tell a teacher if someone says or does something to me online that makes me uncomfortable. I will tell a teacher if I see that someone is making someone else uncomfortable. I will not respond to anyone who shares inappropriate material with me.
8. I understand that if I don't follow these rules, I can lose the privilege of using technology at school. I could also get in trouble with my teacher or principal.
